III. SCOPE OF WORK/SPECIFICATIONS

The South Carolina Department of Transportation is seeking bids for a 50 X 36' Hollow Core Bridge, precast concrete barrier rails, & Crane and Operator for Road S-45-0194 Williamsburg County – {See Attachment A– Map}. All work shall conform to all specifications listed within this solicitation.

Bridge Requirements

2 Each – 50 Ft. Exterior Slabs

10 Each –50 Ft. Interior Slabs for a 36 Ft. Roadway.

Bridges and components must include all hardware, elastomeric bearing pads, cold applied joint filler and non-shrink grout.

Elastomeric bearing pads must be 34" in length.

Bridge and components must be built in accordance with the Standard Drawings for Bridges, June 2010.

Barrier Rail Requirements

Barrier Rails – (60' Linear Feet), 4 Sections 15' each with Drain Slots / Without Guardrail Attachment Holes.

(40 Linear Feet), 4 Sections 10' each Without Drain Slots / With Guardrail Attachment Holes..

Contractor shall use item(s) from the Qualified Products List 7 – Barrier Rail Coatings. {See Attachment C }

Contractor shall use the Approved Vendors List to procure Barrier Rail Coatings {See Attachment D }

Barrier rails must be coated in accordance with the 2007 Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, Sections 702.4.11.3 and 702.4.11.4. {See Attachment E }.

Barrier rails must be delivered on a separate trailer.

Crane/Operator Requirement

Contractor shall provide crane and operator. Contractor shall provide all lifting equipment, rigging and operator to set Bridge and all its components. The crane must meet current OSHA Regulations:
