The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) is seeking bids for two (2) each electric hydraulic mobile column lifts. The independent lifting columns must be able to work in tandem with each other to synchronize its lifting capacity. The **electric hydraulic mobile column lift** ~~mobile lift column~~ must have an onboard programmable logic controller (PLC **digital computer**).

~~The Lift column frames must have a minimum lift capacity rating of 18,000 pounds (lbs.) each plus a combined lift capacity rating of 36,000 lbs. when the two (2) are in use.~~

III. SCOPE OF WORK/SPECIFICATIONS

The **electric hydraulic mobile column lift** ~~column Lift system~~ controls must allow the columns to work/function in tandem without modifying the electrical system and provide a single control operation from either column. The **electric hydraulic mobile column** ~~columns~~ **lift** must be equipped with a gauge that displays the weight of each column while an object is under lift. Each **of the electric hydraulic mobile column lift** shall have a reel that safely retracts the cable so the connection cables stay off of the floor. The **electric hydraulic mobile column lift** ~~lift equipment~~ must comply with all applicable local, State and Federal regulations and meet the latest OSHA, and national recognized testing laboratory certification program standards (UL, NEC, ALI and ANSI).

The electric hydraulic mobile column lift frames must have a minimum lift capacity rating of 18,000 pounds (lbs.) each plus a combined lift rating of 36,000 lbs. when the two (2) are in use.

The electric hydraulic mobile column lift system must have the ability to raise a variety of vehicles (light trucks, passenger vehicles, vans, etc.). Prospective Offeror must have a location within a two-hundred (200) mile radius of Marion County's Maintenance facility in the event of repair or preventive maintenance. The Mohawk MP-18 Series and Rotary Mach 4 Series illustrate the salient characteristics/features SCDOT is seeking for the desired end product.

Electrical Controls

1. An onboard transformer must be physically attached to each column to allow for incoming electricity to be converted to 110v output.
2. The transformers shall be in an enclosed self-contained weather proof housing unit.
3. Must have a programmable logic controller (**PLC digital computer**) and built in battery charger.
4. One (1) communication control cable must be supplied for each column.
5. The lift controls must synchronize with each other to form a single unit interface.
6. The lift must be battery operated and battery shall be included with the lift.
7. The lift must have quick connect cords to allow for the connection to each column.
8. The control cable shall meet current OSHA safety standards.

Column Movement and Steering

1. The **electric hydraulic mobile column lift** movement and steering shall have a pallet jack style **or equivalent features** ~~device that will to~~ allow movement, ~~plus have a three (3) lever position that has a setting to will lower and raise the lift, plus placing the lift in and a neutral setting.~~
2. The **electric hydraulic mobile column lift** must be able to turn ~~in a 90 degrees angle~~ to allow the user to make turns into a tight storage area, ~~plus have a turning radius of fifty (50) inches.~~

Wheel Base

1. The wheel base shall ~~be spring loaded and~~ retract when the **electric hydraulic mobile column lift** is under load.
2. When the **electric hydraulic mobile column lift** wheel base is retracted, the **lift** columns weight must bear onto the flat surface resulting in an even load displacement on the columns.

Jack Stands

1. The offeror shall include in its bid proposal the price for four (4) each portable jack stands rated at 18,000 lbs..
2. The jack stands must have wheels that will allow individual to move them without lifting.
3. The Jack stands must be at a minimum of 56 inches in height and adjust to a maximum height of 82 inches.

Kits

1. The offeror shall include in its bid the price for two (2) each front and rear frame engaging kit and fork bumper adaptor.
2. The front and rear frame engaging kit must have a minimum lift capacity of 6,000 lbs..

Hydraulic Fluid

1. The lift hydraulic fluid shall be included in the bid price.
2. The offeror's lift must contain the manufacturer's recommended hydraulic fluid.
3. The offeror must insure the lift hydraulic fluid operating level is correct at the date of delivery.
